HSC Code of Conduct

HORNING SAILING CLUB ('the Club') expects all users to show respect and understanding to each other, treat everyone equally and conduct themselves in a way that reflects the principles of the Club. The Club aims for all users to enjoy the club and their sport.

- Avoid the use of language that others may find offensive, whether on Club premises, at a Club event, or when using the Club's social media channels.
- Encourage all Members to play as full a role in the Club as they wish to and support them in developing their skills and experience.
- Recognise the contribution of coaches, instructors, officials and volunteers.
- Prioritise the safety and wellbeing of participants.
- Promote courtesy to other water users.
- Help create/maintain a friendly and welcoming atmosphere.
- Use established procedures where there is a genuine concern or dispute.

Club Members can expect to: -

- Feel welcome and valued.
- Be respected and treated fairly.
- Be listened to and kept informed.
- Be involved and contribute towards decisions within the Club.
